The Proposed Income for January 1 - December 31, 2023 was \$119,729.02 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$119,729.02. The average weekly income for January - December was \$2,163.52

The December 1-31, 2023 income of \$15,502.55 exceeded the expenses of \$12,978.45 for the same period by \$2,524.10. The proposed income for December was \$9,209.93. The proposed expense for December was \$11,009.90. The average weekly income for December was \$3,100.51.

7% of the General Fund Offerings was given to Missions during 2023. This amount was divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$7,842.22 was equally divided between these two missions during January through December 2023.
