The Proposed Income for January 1 – April 30, 2024 was \$40,184.41 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$41,488.21. The average weekly income for January 1 – April 30, 2024 was \$2,436.07.

The April 1 – 31, 2024 income of \$8,045.61 exceeded the expenses for April 1 – 30 by \$583.45. The Proposed Income for April was \$9,455.16. The Proposed Expenses for April was \$8,110.05. The average weekly offering for April was \$2,011.40.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$2,795.73 was equally divided between these two missions during January through April, 2024.
