

The January 1 – May 31, 2024 income of \$50,186.61 exceeded the expenses of \$44,910.79 for the same period by \$5,275.82. The Proposed Income for January 1 – May 31, 2024 was \$49,639.57 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$49,924.14. The average weekly income for January 1 – May 31, 2024 was \$2,389.84.

The May 1-31, 2024 income of \$8,773.49 exceeded the expenses for May 1-31 by \$932.10. The Proposed Income for May was \$9,455.16. The Proposed Expenses for May was \$8,435.93. The average weekly offering for May was \$2,193.37.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$3,376.03 was equally divided between these two missions during January through May, 2024.
