The January 1 – June 30, 2024 income of \$59,628.05 exceeded the expenses of \$53,005.58 for the same period by \$6,622.47. The Proposed Income for January 1 – June 30, 2024 was \$61,458.52 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$62,876.29. The average weekly income for January 1 – June 30, 2024 was \$2,293.39.

The June 1-30, 2024 income of \$9,441.44 exceeded the expenses for June 1-30 by \$1,346.65. The Proposed Income for June was \$11,818.95. The Proposed Expenses for June was \$12,952.15. The average weekly offering for June was \$1,888.29.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$4,000.36 was equally divided between these two missions during January through June, 2024.
