The January 1 – July 31, 2024 income of \$73,044.43 exceeded the expenses of \$61,755.92 for the same period by \$11,288.51. The Proposed Income for January 1 – July 31, 2024 was \$70,913.68 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$72,856.13. The average weekly income for January 1 – July 31, 2024 was \$2,434.81.

The July 1 – 30, 2024 income of \$13,266.38 exceeded the expenses for July 1 – 30 by \$4,516.04. The Proposed Income for July was \$9,455.16. The Proposed Expenses for July was \$9,979.84. The average weekly offering for July was \$3,316.59.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$4,917.71 was equally divided between these two missions during January through July, 2024.

 - ◇ **Checking & Money Market Accounts** – contain the General Fund as well as several other funds designated for different uses.
 - ◇ **General Fund** – for use in general operating expense.
 - ◇ **Benevolence Fund** – for use in meeting benevolent needs.
 - ◇ **Food Pantry Fund** – for use in purchasing food for those in need.
 - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** – for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
 - ◇ **Camp Scholarship Fund** – for use in helping campers with Christian Camp fees.
 - ◇ **Renovation Fund** – this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
 - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** – this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement.
