The January 1 – August 31, 2024 income of \$79,886.37 exceeded the expenses of \$68,996.75 for the same period by \$10,889.62. The Proposed Income for January 1 – August 31, 2024 was \$80,368.84 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$81,334.39. The average weekly income for January 1 – August 31, 2024 was \$2,282.47.

The August 1-30, 2024 income of \$6,841.94 fell short of the expenses for August 1-30 by \$398.89. The Proposed Income for August was \$9,455.16. The Proposed Expenses for August was \$8,478.26. The average weekly offering for August was \$1,710.48.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$5,387.69 was equally divided between these two missions during January through August, 2024.
