The January 1 – September 30, 2024 income of \$89,378.81 exceeded the expenses of \$77,446.60 for the same period by \$11,932.21. The Proposed Income for January 1 – September 30, 2024 was \$92,187.77 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$93,086.19. The average weekly income for January 1 – September 30, 2024 was \$2,291.76.

The September 1 - 30, 2024 income of \$9,492.44 exceeded the expenses for September 1 - 30 by \$1,042.59. The Proposed Income for September was \$11,818.93. The Proposed Expenses for September was \$11,751.80. The average weekly offering for September was \$1,898.49.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$6,044.64 was equally divided between these two missions during January through September, 2024.
