

The January 1 – October 31, 2024 income of \$97,689.31 exceeded the expenses of \$86,168.94 for the same period by \$11,520.37. The Proposed Income for January 1 – October 31, 2024 was \$101,642.92 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$101,583.33. The average weekly income for January 1 – October 31, 2024 was \$2,271.84.

The October 1 - 31, 2024 income of \$8,310.50 fell short of the expenses for October 1 - 31 by \$411.84. The Proposed Income for October was \$9,455.15. The Proposed Expenses for October was -\$746.99. The average weekly offering for October was \$2,180.58.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$6,620.39 was equally divided between these two missions during January through October, 2024.
