The January 1 – November 30, 2024 income of \$110,352.11 exceeded the expenses of \$94,377.81 for the same period by \$15,974.30. The Proposed Income for January 1 – November 30, 2024 was \$111,098.07 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$110,125.36. The average weekly income for January 1 – November 30, 2024 was \$2,343.23.

The November 1-30, 2024 income of \$12,662.80 exceeded the expenses for November 1-30 by \$4,453.93. The Proposed Income for November was \$9,455.15. The Proposed Expenses for November was \$8,587.03. The average weekly offering for November was \$3,165.70.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2024. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$7,500.99 was equally divided between these two missions during January through November, 2024.
