The January 1 – December 31, 2025 income of \$122,158.80 exceeded the expenses of \$119,191.49 for the same period by \$2,967.31. The Proposed Income for January 1 – December 31, 2025 was \$120,696.00 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$120,696.00. The average weekly income for January 1 – December 31, 2025 was \$2,349.21.

The December 1-31, 2025 income of \$8,323.86 fell short the expenses of \$10,580.78 for December by **\$2,256.92**. The Proposed Income for December was \$9,284.31. The Proposed Expenses for December was \$10,076.61. The average weekly income for December 2025 was \$2,080.96.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2025. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$8,085.91 was equally divided between these two missions for January—December, 2025.

 - ◇ **Checking & Money Market Accounts** – contain the General Fund as well as several other funds designated for different uses.
 - ◇ **General Fund** – for use in general operating expense.
 - ◇ **Benevolence Fund** – for use in meeting benevolent needs.
 - ◇ **Food Pantry Fund** – for use in purchasing food for those in need.
 - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** – for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
 - ◇ **Camp Scholarship Fund** – for use in helping campers with Christian Camp fees.
 - ◇ **Renovation Fund** – this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
 - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** – this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement.
