

The January 1 – January 31, 2026 income of \$7,779.87 fell short of the expenses of \$11,362.58 for the same period by **\$3,582.71**. The Proposed Income for January 1 – January 31, 2026 was \$9,508.55 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$11,547.00. The average weekly income for January 1 – January 31, 2026 was \$1,944.97. The average includes a zero offering for January 25 when the church did not meet because of snow.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2026. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$511.07 was equally divided between these two missions for January 1-31, 2026. Offerings were received for only three Sundays in January because of a snow day.

  - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** – for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
  - ◇ **Renovation Fund** – this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
  - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** – this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement.
