The January 1 – February 28, 2026 income of \$17,985.47 fell short of the expenses of \$20,837.33 for the same period by \$2,851.86. The Proposed Income for January 1 – February 28, 2026 was \$19,017.10 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$23,486.21. The average weekly income for January 1 – February 28, 2026 was \$2,248.18.

The February 1-28, 2026 income of \$10,205.60 exceeded the expenses of \$9,279.24 for the same period by \$926.36. The Proposed Income for February 1-28, 2026 was \$9,508.55 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$10,791.90. The average weekly income for February, 2026 was \$2,551.40.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2026. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$1,201.97 was equally divided between these two missions for January—February, 2026.

  - ◇ **Food Pantry Fund** – for use in purchasing food for those in need.
  - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** – for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
  - ◇ **Renovation Fund** – this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
  - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** – this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement.
