The January 1 – May 31, 2026 income of \$52,853.10 exceeded the expenses of \$51,120.57 for the same period by \$1,732.53. The Proposed Income for January 1 – May 31, 2026 was \$52,296.97 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$54,832.34. The average weekly income for January 1 – May 31, 2026 was \$2,402.41.

The May 1-31, 2026 income of \$9,568.92 exceeded the expenses of \$9,137.45 for the same period by \$431.47. The Proposed Income for May 1-31, 2026 was \$11,885.66 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$9,198.60. The average weekly income for May, 2026 was \$1,913.78.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2026. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$3,553.76 was equally divided between these two missions for January—May, 2026.

 - ◇ **Checking & Money Market Accounts** – contain the General Fund as well as several other funds designated for different uses.
 - ◇ **General Fund** – for use in general operating expense.
 - ◇ **Benevolence Fund** – for use in meeting benevolent needs.
 - ◇ **Food Pantry Fund** – for use in purchasing food for those in need.
 - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** – for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
 - ◇ **Renovation Fund** – this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
 - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** – this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement.
