The January 1 – June 30, 2026 income of \$61,783.88 exceeded the expenses of \$61,316.24 for the same period by \$467.64. The Proposed Income for January 1 – June 30, 2026 was \$61,783.88 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$64,312.54. The average weekly income for January 1 – June 30, 2026 was \$2,376.30.

The June 1-30, 2026 income of \$8,915.80 fell short of the expenses of \$10,180.69 for the same period by \$1,264.89. The Proposed Income for June 1-30, 2026 was \$9,508.55 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$8,433.32. The expenses for June included the \$1,057.52 replacement of the garage door. The average weekly income for June, 2026 was \$2,228.95.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2026. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$4,153.87 was equally divided between these two missions for January—June, 2026.

 - ◇ **Checking & Money Market Accounts** — contain the General Fund as well as several other funds designated for different uses.
 - ◇ **General Fund** — for use in general operating expense.
 - ◇ **Benevolence Fund** — for use in meeting benevolent needs.
 - ◇ **Food Pantry Fund** — for use in purchasing food for those in need.
 - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** — for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
 - ◇ **Renovation Fund** — this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
 - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** — this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement.
