The January 1 – July 31, 2026 income of \$71,727.43 exceeded the expenses of \$71,599.85 for the same period by \$127.58. The Proposed Income for January 1 – July 31, 2026 was \$71,314.07 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$75,628.77. The average weekly income for January 1 – July 31, 2026 was \$2,390.91.

The July 1-31, 2026 income of \$9,943.55 fell short of the expenses of \$10,471.83 for the same period by \$528.28. The Proposed Income for July 1-31, 2026 was \$9,508.55 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$8,433.32. The Expenses for July included the quarterly property and liability insurance premium of \$4,542.75.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2026. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$4,781.07 was equally divided between these two missions for January—July, 2026.

- ◆ Balance Sheet Information . . .
 - ◇ **Checking & Money Market Accounts** — contain the General Fund as well as several other funds designated for different uses.
 - ◇ **General Fund** — for use in general operating expense.
 - ◇ **Benevolence Fund** — for use in meeting benevolent needs.
 - ◇ **Food Pantry Fund** — for use in purchasing food for those in need.
 - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** — for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
 - ◇ **Renovation Fund** — this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
 - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** — this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement. Next month this fund will be combined with the Renovation Fund.
