**Website is temporarily out of order . . .**

Our website has crashed and a new, replacement website is being built. Hopefully the new website will be up and running by July 25, 2025. In the interim, Prayer Lists are being sent by attachments to email. Sermon video and audio links will be sent by email and videos of the sermon are posted on the Springboro Christian Church page on Facebook.



The January 1 – June 30, 2025 income of \$62,199.28 exceeded the expenses of \$59,927.28 for the same period by \$2,272.00. The Proposed Income for January 1 – June 30, 2025 was \$60,347.98 and the Proposed Expense for the same period was \$62,002.12. The average weekly income for January 1 – June 30, 2025 was \$2,392.28.

The June 1-30, 2025 income of \$10,199.95 exceeded the expenses of \$9,157.79 for June by \$1,042.16. The Proposed Income for June was \$11,605.39. The Proposed Expenses for June was \$8,402.10. The average weekly income for June 2025 was \$2,039.99. Expenses for June included the purchase of a new sewage lift station (basement) and roof repair over the worship center.

7% of the General Fund Offerings is being given to Missions during 2025. This amount is being divided equally between Central India Christian Mission and Butler Springs Christian Camp. \$4,191.25 was equally divided between these two missions for January—June, 2025.

  - ◇ **Checking & Money Market Accounts** – contain the General Fund as well as several other funds designated for different uses.
  - ◇ **General Fund** – for use in general operating expense.
  - ◇ **Benevolence Fund** – for use in meeting benevolent needs.
  - ◇ **Food Pantry Fund** – for use in purchasing food for those in need.
  - ◇ **Audio/Visual Fund** – for use in purchasing audio and visual equipment needs, upgrades, and repairs.
  - ◇ **Camp Scholarship Fund** – for use in helping campers with Christian Camp fees.
  - ◇ **Renovation Fund** – this fund is for carpet/flooring replacement, paint, and other renovation/restoration expense.
  - ◇ **Building/Carpet Fund** – this fund is designated for the replacement cost of carpet, tile, or other building improvement.
